He has impacted over thousand's students, creating a stress-free learning environment at the Maharana Mewar Public School and Maharana Mewar Vidya Mandir by integrating academics with arts, crafts, music, and robotics.


During COVID-19, he coordinated essential supplies, providing food, hygiene kits, and services to vulnerable communities, underscoring his dedication to social welfare on a wide scale. In addition, he works in diverse areas including women empowerment, animal welfare, the welfare of army widows (a 450-year-old generational initiative) and former members of the Army and Police force.

Global Custodian of Heritage

As a Chairman and Managing Trustee of Maharana of Mewar Charitable Foundation his work revitalizes historical sites and promotes sustainable tourism while taking Udaipur's vibrant art and culture to international museums like London's Victoria & Albert Museum and New York's Metropolitan Museum of Art; The Kunsthalle Der Hypo-Kulturstiftung, Munich; The Chateau de Chambord, France; National Museum of Asian Art, Washington, DC; The Cleveland Museum of Art, Ohio with the Smithsonian Institution, USA; The Museum Rietberg, Zurich, amongst others. As President of the Maharana Pratap Smarak Samiti, Shriji preserves the tangible and intangible heritage of Mewar with modern relevance. Through these initiatives, he celebrates Mewar's legacy while adapting its spirit to inspire a global audience.

Environmentalist and Record Holder

Shriji's commitment to environmental causes is demonstrated through his numerous initiatives for conservation and sustainability. Through the Maharana of Mewar Charitable Foundation, he addresses issues like deforestation, pollution, and water conservation. His 'Go Green' movement and #SaveWater campaigns engage citizens and school children alike, raising awareness for ecological responsibility.



Shriji holds an impressive nine Guinness World Records for his impactful environmental and charitable initiatives, each exemplifying his dedication to creating meaningful change. His records include pioneering large-scale efforts such as Vastradaan, the world's largest collection of clothes for recycling and donation (2019), and the world's largest collection of school supplies gathered in just 24 hours (2019). Through Go Green, or Vriksh Hi Jeevan Abhiyaan, he brought together thousands of participants to set the record for the most people potting plants simultaneously (2020), promoting environmental awareness and reforestation. His record-setting work continued with the largest donation of personal hygiene products in one hour (2021), the world's longest line of hunger relief packages (2022), and the largest sweater donation in an hour (2022). In 2023, he coordinated the planting of the most seeds in one hour with Seeds of Future, while in 2024, he held the world's largest stress management lesson, Busting Exam Stress, aimed at supporting students' mental health. In 2025 he achieved another record by having the largest display of solar powered lamps. These achievements not only spotlight his environmental advocacy but also reflect his commitment to philanthropy on a global scale.

A Leader in Hospitality and a passion for sports

Through HRH Group of Hotels and as the brand ambassador for the Taj Group of Hotels, he promotes heritage tourism and cultural preservation. His work in hospitality merges conservation with community engagement, generating local employment while celebrating Rajasthan's rich heritage.

In his role with the Udaipur District Cricket Association (UDCA) he passionately promotes cricket in Rajasthan. As Chairperson he advocated for enhanced facilities for players, coaches, and ground staff, paving the way for a new generation of cricketers. His vision includes creating a world-class pitch in Udaipur, inspiring young athletes to pursue excellence in sports.

A Renaissance Man for a New Era

Beyond his public work, Shriji is an accomplished artist, chef, photographer, and aero-modeling enthusiast. He is a collector of diecast car models and formulated a unique perfume which represents the house of Mewar with its fragrance and ingredients.

For securing First Position in MBA examination he is awarded University Gold Medal and Certificate of Merit.
